WHERE DO YOU PERFORM YOUR PROCEDURES?

We perform all procedures in-house. Our office area can accommodate patients receiving injectables or skin resurfacing treatments, while cosmetic surgery is performed in our dedicated surgery center.

For example, Ulthera®, a device that uses ultrasound energy to tighten skin, is a nonsurgical option for tissue lifting. Procedures like Ulthera, which offer minimal bruising and practically no downtime, are the wave of the future," he says. As the focus of his practice, appearance-enhancing treatments range from Ulthera and facelifts to rhinoplasty. Dr. Beaty will often recommend using these in combination for a fully rejuvenated face.
